Composition

100 g solution contains:

Active ingredients: 79,9 g ethanol 96 %,

Other ingredients: butan-2-one, macrogolglycerolcocoate, fragrance, lactic acid, purified water

Range of application

Control of bacteria (incl. Tb), fungi and enveloped viruses, rota virus, adeno virus

Disinfection of hands and non-injured skin

Mode of application / dosage

Use externally and undiluted only!

Surgical hand disinfection

Pour at least 5 ml AHD 2000[®] in the palm of the hands and rub on hands and forearms until dry, giving particular attention to the fingertips and to the areas around the nails. Duration: 1 1/2 min. each.

Hygienic hand rub

(Also appropriate for use according to §18 of the German Law for the prevention of infectious diseases (IfSG)

Keep hands wet by the concentrated product during the whole exposure time:

concentrated at least 3 ml - 30 sec

Skin disinfection

Wet the area to be disinfected completely with AHD 2000 and allow to dry completely. especially before using thermo-electrical appliances on the skin.

Before punctures and injections

concentrated at least 15 sec:

Before punctures of articulations, body cavities,

hollow organs, and before surgery

concentrated at least 1 min

On skin with a lot of sebaceous glands (for ex. forehead):

concentrated at least 1 min

Virucidal* against enveloped viruses incl. HBV/HCV/HIV,

Rota virus and Adeno virus

concentrated - 30 sec

*according to recommendation of Robert Koch Institute Berlin/ Federal Health Gazette 01/2004

Warnings / storage

- Do not apply on wounds or mucous membranes.
- AHD 2000® is highly flammable (flash point acc. to DIN 51 755: 19 °C).
- Do not spray in open flame.
- Do not store above 25 °C, keep drugs out of reach of children and away from ignition sources.
- Do not use beyond expiry date.

- Well tolerated by the skin (even after frequent use)

Application schedule for surgical hand disinfection

Surgical hand disinfection	Product	Mode of application
Prior to surgery: Pre-cleansing	Majola [®] or Wasa [®] 2000	Wet hands and forearms, wash with Majola [®] or Wasa [®] 2000, rinse well and dry.
Disinfection	AHD 2000 [®]	Min. 5 ml AHD 2000 [®] Rub on hands and forearms until dry, giving particular attention to fingertips and nails. Duration: 1 ½ min. each
After surgery: Washing	Majola [®] or Wasa [®] 2000	Wet hands and forearms, wash with Majola [®] or Wasa [®] 2000, rinse well and dry.
Skin care	Majola [®] -H5- Creme	Apply thinly to skin/hands and rub in.
